We know she will be sorely missed.

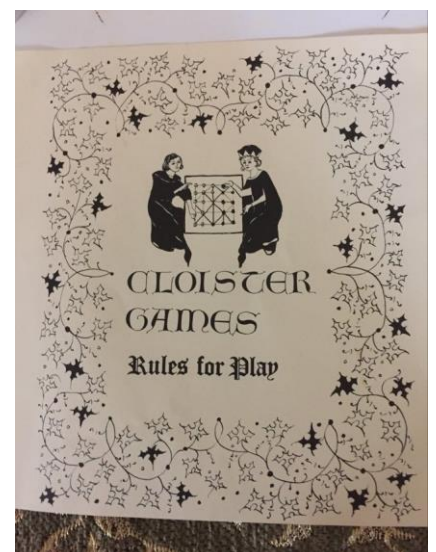

Council Meeting Minutes 1st of July 2020

Present: Jayne, Kotek, Elena, Vigdis, Rat, Richard, Ginevra, Lowrens, William de Cameron and Katherina, Aveline, Anna de Wilde

Apologies: Agnes, Elisabetta, Adrienne, Alexandra and Grim

Meeting Opens 7:33pm

1. Previous Month's meetings. Elena moves to accept the minutes.

Vigdis seconds. 0 Nays, 5 abstentions, 4 Yes. Minutes pass.

1. Business Arising: FAT policy.

Policy has been rewritten. Links to be added later.

There was some discussion around the wording around promissory. And what happens if a project is abandoned and/or refunds are needed.

Seneschal's report: FAT policy, correspondences with various groups

Reeve's report: Not received

Herald's report: Baron Callum did the voice heralding at BA and Lady Sigrith ran a good book heraldry session and has some submissions under way. A few nibbles for a new herald...

Chronicler's report: Making FTT as this meeting is happening.

Knight Marshall: Attended fighters practices, even had a new attendee get into armour, we seem to be low on kidney belts, I'm sure we had a variety previously. BA tournaments happened, Marshalled mostly by Baron Grimm the heavy tournament consisted of a best of three double elimination fought between Baron Ratbot, Baron Callum, Baron Richard, Baron Brian, Baron Torvaldr, Master James, Lady Gisle and Lord Loki.
