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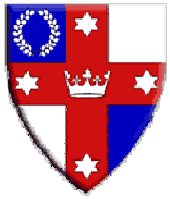
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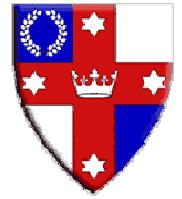

Baronial Succession Information

Unto the Barony of Southron Gaard, does Prince Cornelius and Princess Elizabeth, Heirs to Gabriel and Constanzia, Crown of Lochac, send greetings wishing good health and happiness to you and your house.

The process for the determination for the Fifth Baron and Baroness of Southron Gaard has been delegated to Us by Gabriel and Constanzia, King and Queen of Lochac.

The process for the determination of the next Baron and Baroness of Southron Gaard will be as follows:

Nomination Process

We will be allowing time for the members of the populace to consider whether or not they wish to consider nominating for role of Baron and Baroness for one month from this notice.

Nominations for the position of Baron and Baroness of Southron Gaard will now open from 10th September and to be made via email to Us royal@lochac.sca.org and to the Seneschal of Lochac Seneschal seneschal@lochac.sca.org by the 24th day of September. Each nomination will include a letter outlining the experience of the candidates in the SCA and whatever other skills they have to lend to the role, and their intent for the group and region. These letters will then be forwarded

on to the local mailing lists by the Seneschal of Lochac on the 25th day of September 2011.

Discussion between Candidates and Populace

There will be two weeks (the 25th of September until the 9th of September) between the announcement of the Candidates and the beginning of polling, which the candidates will use to discuss their ideas and intentions for the Barony with the populace. This will be done using the group mailing lists and websites. In person meetings are also an option for your Barony and can be arranged during this period. A forum has been set up to manage this process in consideration of geography of the Barony of Southron Gaard - <http://ildhafn.sca.org.nz/forum>

Consultation Process (The Poll)

According to Corpora and the Lochac Laws, the Crown has the responsibility of choosing successors based on the written advice of members of the Barony, and the decision must not be substantively opposed by the populace. We have opted to poll the populace to ensure that these criteria are met when making Our decision.

Poll will open on the 9th of October 2011 and shall conclude on the 23rd of October.

1) This poll will be done electronically - please send your comments directly to royal@lochac.sca.org

2) We are seeking the opinion of those who directly participate with the Barony of Southron Gaard.

3) We will consider the opinions of gentles located in other groups, however greater weight will be placed on the opinions of those who live within the boundaries of the Barony, and who are paid members of the SCA.

4) Send your recommendation to Us is to be in the following format:

1. Candidates who are your first preference, with reasons for this preference.
2. Candidates who are your second preference, with reasons.
3. (etc).

Your Recommendation to us will include:

A) Personal information about yourself such as: membership number, Barony/Canton you reside in and a brief outline of your participation level (depth of experience/group/SCA)

B) Your personal contact details so that if your recommendation is not clear to Us, We can choose to contact you to clarify.

C) Strengths and weaknesses of all candidates in order of preference. This

needs to be very clearly articulated so that We understands your wishes.

We ask if you can please advise us, regardless of your preference, whether you would support each set of candidates as the Baron and Baroness of Southron Gaard.

If you feel you cannot support any of the candidates, or you strongly feel that the Barony needs more time please indicate this clearly. Please note, a Vicar, The Honourable Lady Amalie von Brisache, will be in place from the 3rd of July 2011 until the investiture of the new Baron and Baroness at Canterbury Faire 2012.

5) Your recommendation to Us will remain confidential. Please feel free to be open and honest, but do note that this is not an opportunity for personal attack or malice. We ask that where possible an impartial and unbiased observation be made with a view of the best benefits for the Barony and greater region for Our consideration.

6) Please be aware that if insufficient information is received, We may choose to opt for alternative candidates than the nominees. It is vital that as many of you participate in this consultation process as possible.

We will be requesting a current membership list from the SCANZ Registrar for your Barony to ensure that we have sufficient majority of members

participating.

The Decision Process

We will be dedicating ourselves to reading and considering all of your input. We understand that this is a very stressful time for the candidates in particular so we will be making the decision swiftly based on your advice. We hope to have a decision finalised on the 31st of October 2011 if not earlier.

Communication regarding the outcome of Our decision to the candidates and to the Barony of Southron Gaard.

Successful and unsuccessful candidates will be advised by a phone call from Us after We have finalised Our decision. The Seneschal of Lochac will then send an electronic announcement to the local lists advising you of this decision.

The decision of appointing the next Baron and Baroness of Southron Gaard is a weighty and important one to the Kingdom of Lochac, and due consideration will be taken. It is very important that you take the opportunity of participating within stipulated time lines for your voice to be heard by Us.

This is a very exciting time for Southron Gaard and we wish you all good luck. We look forward to reading your recommendations.

Comments:

The significant loss showing this year of \$6225.85 is due to almost \$13000 worth of expenses relating to events from the prior year, being the payment for Canterbury Faire's site fees, and catching up on SCANZ and Kingdom Levies and share of profits. Had this been accounted for in the previous year, the profit of \$2649.46 that was reported for the year ended March 2010 would have instead been a loss of \$10095.60, which would have been a very big call for concern. This dramatically highlights the need for event stewards to complete their reports in a timely manner so that all event costs can be paid as promptly as possible.

If we were to ignore these expenses, the March 2011 year would have instead reported a profit of \$6519.21, largely as a result of the profit from Canterbury Faire 2011. If we look at non-event related income and expenditure (shown above as Officer and Regular Meeting/Practices) we very much spent more than we took in with expenses exceeding income by approximately \$2400. This was partially offset by some unusual income, including a donation of \$1000 for assisting with a photoshoot, and \$776.01 received from Castleburn as that group was wound up. Our payments for storage though are double what they would normally be (\$730 instead of \$365) again, due to the late payment to the Canterbury Faire site for use of the storage container. We also had what I would consider to be a somewhat larger than necessary printing expense for new business cards. The equipment purchases this year were almost totally for archery supplies, however the archers themselves had done much of the fundraising for this previously.

While the income for this year does include \$386 for Baronial Anniversary 2011, and there are some minor expenses relating to CF 2011 that were finalised after 31 March, no major expenses of the like seen in 2010 are outstanding, so the year to March 2012 should be relatively free of such distortions.

The account balances of \$11385.88 are healthy and certainly will allow us to continue to operate in our normal manner. It will still be important for Canterbury Faire to be taking in pre-payments to cover its expenses, but that would likely be the only event where it would be absolutely necessary.

It would be advisable, I believe, to try to better balance the funding of non-event-related costs to non-event-related income, rather than relying on profitable events to cover these expenses. This might allow event ticket prices to be reduced somewhat, and other costs to be funded from more direct income. Donations for the use of A&S, fencing and dance venues for example have already started, and we may want to consider specific fund-raising activities for other planned expenses this year. With the assistance of the current officers, I will be preparing a budget for this year shortly and will publish that in a future FTT.

OFFICER REPORTS:

SENESCHAL (Oswyn): Correspondence with TRMs,TEs, TRHs and the KS regarding the baronial changeover process. Correspondence also with the new Webwright regarding material regarding the baronial changeover process for the baronial website, and with the KS and Sir William de Cameron and Mistress Eleanora regarding a forum for discussion between the populace and candidates. Correspondence with The baronial vicar-in-waiting. Thanks to Amalie for stepping up for the job. THL Amalie as also expressed a preparedness to look after the running of the poll. Discussion with the St. Kessog Seneschal regarding funding support for a deposit for their Fimbulwinter (see below) – Greetings m'lord and m'lady (depending on who's email is most reliable at present). I hope that the

earthquakes on Monday have not caused too much disruption to you and that you are both well. I freely admit that I have been a little lax when organising the prospective Fimbulwinter event, and due to this the event will be held at the Waioira scout camp a little south of Dunedin. I'm looking to hire the Troop Den (kitchen, hall, 2 bunks) and 2 bunk rooms (8 people each) giving a total of 18 bunks available for the event. In the unlikely event that we have lots of people locals can always go home instead of staying at the venue to make space for non-locals, or can billet non-locals (if it's that successful I'll be amazed). The Troop den is \$80 night and the bunk rooms \$75.00 each, I'm getting clarification on the booking from the Scouts group and am hoping that Southron Gaard will be willing to pay the deposit at least for the site. Chronicler. Applications close end of the month

ARTS AND SCIENCES (Amalie): Seamster's last month at Taddea's; next week it will be at Emilio and Mathilda's. Stuff Night involved sewing labels onto SG garb. We had 4 people. Will do it again next month unless something more exciting comes up

CHATELAINE (Chunegunde): Was contacted by 5 possible newcomers, 4 for fighting, 1 for A & S. 2 are very keen and have some experience in medieval groups. Contacted Agnes and Elena about being Chatelaine for the Night at Yule, they accepted. Labelled about a quarter of the garb at Stuff Night, with THL Amalie, Dama Antonia, and Georgina (newcomer!). If no one comes up with another idea, we will have the same Stuff Night next month. Iron on labels take a bit of experimentation to get to stick correctly, and I completely screwed up one piece of the paper. Also, spent \$4 on fabric as was an end of roll and it was about \$1.50 a metre if I bought the end. Started rewriting the Newcomer's Page for the website. Will continue this in the coming month. Have had contact with Raffe re Arms and Militaria Expo, I won't be able to attend, but will organise some flyers.

KNIGHT MARSHAL (Callum): no report received (Marshal alive, however agreed that Facebook doesn't count as adequate documentation) Supplementary report from Raffe: Pretty quiet month with only a couple of practices as others rained off. Numbers 4-5 and some good training done. Correspondence with Seneschal regarding Antique arms faire in July and responses to volunteers e-mails. Date is Sat 16th July at Riccarton Racecourse and ideally could use a couple more for Rapier demo and 1 for heavy. Purchased and attached heavy duty plugs for new ovens. Receipt forwarded for reimbursement

CAPTAIN OF ARCHERS (Geoffrey): Continued to hold practises when weather is

cooperative. Started armour-making workshops, with thanks to Sir Tycho for his assistance. Reasonable interest so far. Correspondence with Lord Emilio, regarding use of Kirkwood for rapier practises.

Correspondence: re financial reporting (generally supportive of documentation), re cash handling, gate management (getting gate people trained), re minutes, re CF meal plan follow-up (receipts received are not a true reflection on Gavin's recording keeping). 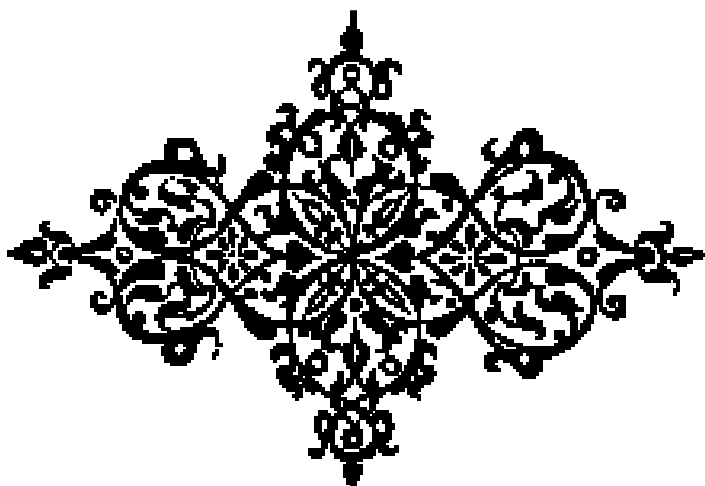
